

MISS TRI-COUNTY RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. Clothing: On Stage Guide

A. Rehearsal clothes

You will need to wear attire of your choice. Shoes should be comfortable. Tennis shoes are suggested. We suggest that you do not try to "break in" new shoes during rehearsal time. However, you may want to bring your runway shoes with you for your practice session on the actual stage. Bring a sweater or light jacket to rehearsal, because the air conditioning in the auditorium is usually very cool.

*Remember, during rehearsal you are not judged nor are you seen by the judges. **Be comfortable.**

B. Cosmetics, Hair, Padding, Swimsuit and Evening gown

Cosmetics should be applied as usual, no drama. Cosmetics should be age appropriate.

Hair- your style of choice. You may be as glamorous as you wish.

Padding/Tapping- are personal options for each contestant.

Swimsuit- Choose what looks best on you. Everyone has the option of a one or two-piece suit. Color and fabric of suit should compliment the contestant.

Evening Gown- should be floor length.

II. Items we must receive

1. **Entry Form-** is to be completed in as much detail as possible.
2. **Photograph-** One 8x10 can be color or black and white, pose of your choice, to be judged for Miss Photogenic.
3. **Entry Fee-** \$100-\$200 (depending on age division) This can be waived by any contestant selling \$400+ in advertising. If you are unable to participate in selling ads, we must have your entry fee.
*This is an incentive that benefits everyone, as the main point is to have a well-designed, top quality, program magazine.

III. Basic Regulations

A. Must be a resident of Kentucky

This is self-explanatory. All we need is a copy of your driver's license, sent along with your entry form. (For Miss contestants only)

B. Must never have been married, and must have no children.

C. CANNOT become married or pregnant while holding the title of Miss Tri-County (in the event this should occur, the first runner-up would receive due title).
